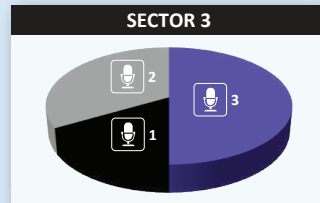

**Notes**

This map represents the distribution of the Somali media outlets per their coverage in Sector 3.

The radio stations are counted in every Somali region where they have a transmitter or a broadcasting capability; the TV Stations are counted in every Somali region where they have a presence (office/studio); the newspapers are counted in every Somali region where they are distributed.

**Radios:** Note that some radio stations also can be listened to across Somalia (as well as outside the country) via shortwave, satellite and/or webstream and are NOT replicated across the map. It is the case for Radio Bar-Kulan (via satellite); BBC Somali Service, Radio Ergo, Radio Hargeisa and VOA Somali Service (via shortwave); and many other Radios such as Radio Dalsan, Radio Ergo, Radio Hirad, Radio Kulmiye, Radio Risala, Radio Shabelle and Raxanreeb (via webstream).

Some radio stations can also be listened to across the country via local radio stations which occasionally relay some of their programmes. These are NOT shown in the map – only media outlets' own transmitting capabilities are. The stations which can be listened to via local relays partners include Radios Bar-Kulan in Bosaso and Galkacyo; BBC Somali Service in Mogadishu, Jawhar, Garowe, Qardho and Bosaso; Radio Ergo in Mogadishu, Guriceel, Cabudwaaq, Caadado and southern Galkacyo; Radio Hirad in Hargeisa, Bosaso, Qardho, Garowe, Galkayo, Cabudwaaq, Beledweyne, Baidoa and Mogadishu; VOA Somali Service in Mogadishu, Baidoa, Guriceel, Cabudwaaq, Galkacyo, Garowe, Qardho and Bosaso.

**Television:** TV stations' coverage is indicated, whether it is international (satellite) or local (terrestrial). Note that TV Royal, Somali Channel, Somsat TV, Universal TV, SNTV, Horn Cable TV and SLNTV all have an international reach and can be listened across Somalia via satellite.
