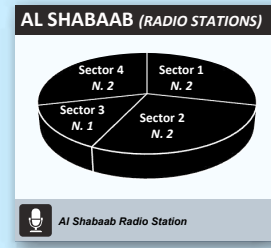
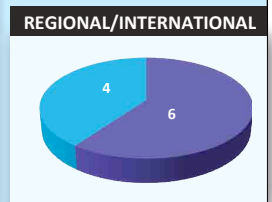
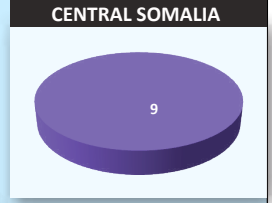
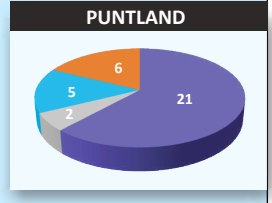
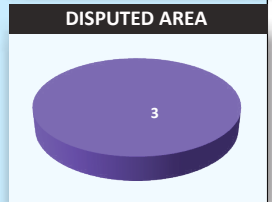
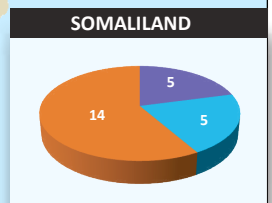
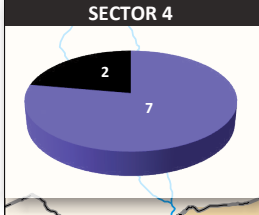
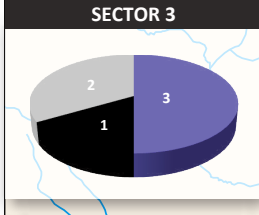
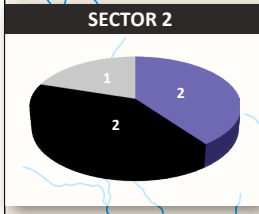
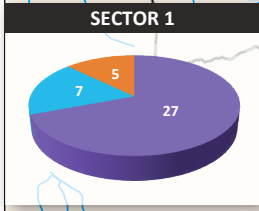
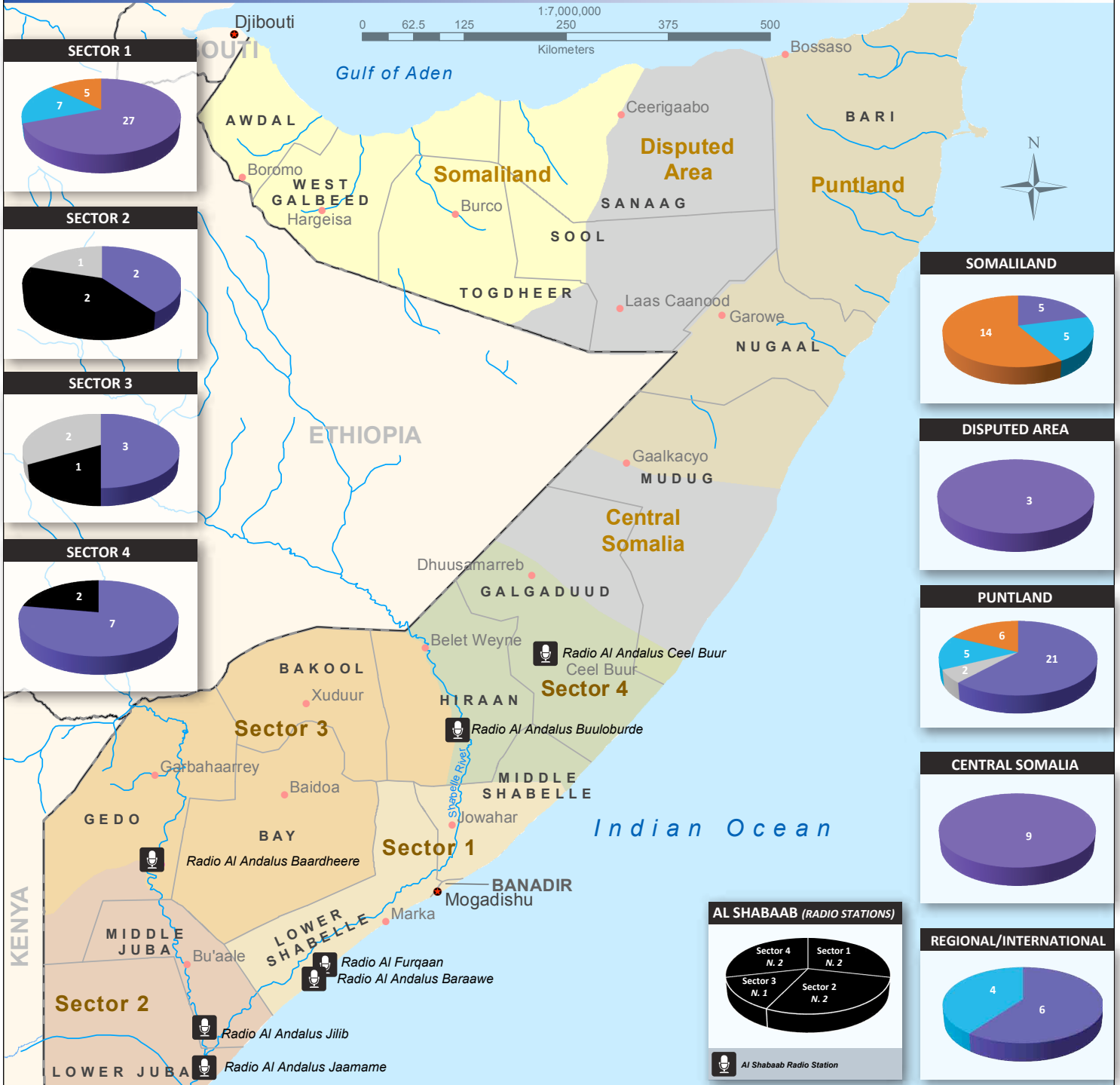


SOMALIA MEDIA DISTRIBUTION - COVERAGE

Notes

This map represents the distribution of the Somali media outlets per their coverage in the whole of Somalia. This means that the outlets are replicated in every sectors/regions where they are accessible (wherever these outlets are present or broadcast) – except for the radio stations that have a national coverage (via shortwave, satellite and/or webstream).

The radio stations are counted in every Somali region where they have a transmitter or a broadcasting capability; the TV Stations are counted in every Somali region where they have a presence (office/studio); the newspapers are counted in every Somali region where they are distributed. This classification "per coverage" reflects the "media offer" for each Somali region i.e identifying the various media outlets that are available in every region, amongst which

media consumers can choose from. This approach is thought for practitioners who are interested in the "coverage", the "reach", in other words to know which media outlets are able to reach a specific city or region – whereas the former approach ("per HQs location") is more useful for those who want to envisage the reality of the structure of the media industry i.e the geographical distribution of the media and the exact number of outlets operating in Somalia overall.
